## Christmas Card Snow Globes

### Instructions:

1. Use a pencil to draw and cut 8 circles that are equal or similar in side to a jar lid..
2. Draw an equilateral triangle on the inside of the card side of your circles.
3. Start pasting the outside parts of the triangles together until it makes a ball. Paste the ribbon into the last section that needs to be glued together.
4. Paste all circles together until it makes a ball. Be sure to tuck in the ribbon on the last section to be pasted together!
5. Enjoy your new decoration on the tree bough of your choice.

### Materials Needed

- a mason jar lid
- pencil
- ruler
- old Christmas cards
- scissors
- glue
- old ribbon
